Online education is a flexible, accessible, and efficient method of learning that learners of all ages can benefit from, by using electronic technology to replace the traditional classroom. Taking an online class helps students use technology in new and different ways. These processes help students to expand their computer and technological skills and be actively involved in what they are learning.

At Toronto High School, each online class involves an OCT (Ontario College of Teachers) certified instructor who communicates with students and helps to convey the material. Our office staff also supports our students with any technical inquiry to facilitate their learning process.

## E-Learning/ Online Delivery:

Toronto High School offers online Grade 9-12 courses to all students who fulfilled prerequisite requirements. The online courses are full credit courses delivered through a virtual classroom setting. Courses are scheduled for 110 hours of instruction and are delivered asynchronously. As part of the learning experience, students will have access to online learning modules, various online tools, simulations, and/ or examples, as well as online discussion forums. Course teachers are available through forums and email, and occasionally in face-to-face/ video telephony sessions to support students throughout the course. Students are required to have internet access to complete these courses. Some of these tools may be available for on-site students.

# Why Online Courses?

**1.**

**Flexible schedule and environment:** Learn anytime, anywhere, which also improves student's self-discipline, responsibility, and time management skills. Students may log on any time they are available, and work wherever they feel comfortable.

**Lower costs:** Students have the opportunity to use what they have at home and usually do not have to purchase anything extra, except for some art supplies for our art courses. Moreover, submitting assignments electronically, eliminates the need to print materials, which is environmental friendly, and also reduces costs.

**Save your time and money, avoid commuting:** During snowstorms and thunderstorms, rather than missing important classes, students in our online classes can always attend their classes and save on fuel and transportation costs, with no commute for classes.

## Reporting student achievement to parents

Our school counselors will call the parents/guardians of a student at least once a month to discuss their child's progress. We encourage the parents/guardians to get in touch with school staffs more frequent. Also, Parents/Guardians are encouraged to login to our Moodle platform which will allow them to access their children's academic progress, and their attendance during the academic school year.

A report card will be provided to the student and parents twice per course, one mid-way through the course, and one at the end of the course. A report card will be sent to the student's parents and/or guardians by mail after the completion of every course. The original copy will be mailed to the parent/guardian and the student shall receive a photocopy of their grade report.

A midterm report card will be issued when students have completed approximately half of the course material (~55 hours of a full credit course).

A final report card will be issued when students have completed all requirements for a course, including all assignments, tests, discussion postings, learning logs and the final exam.
